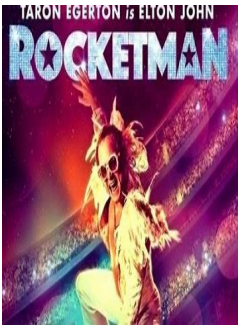




MOVIE REVIEWS

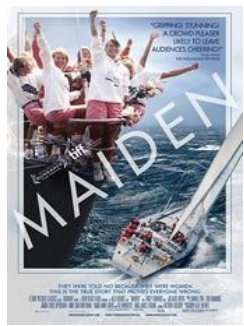
Late Night Rated R 102 minutes Comedy

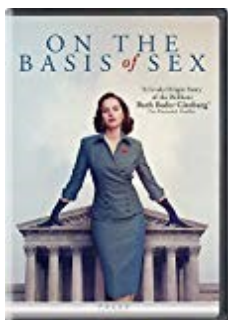
Long Shot Rated R 125 minutes Comedy

Age 15+ 3/5 Stars. Mature but easygoing romantic comedy about a presidential candidate who hires her childhood friend/babysitting charge to be her speechwriter. Two scenes have very mature content that have strong sex and drug issues. Frequent and strong language. Positive message about love and pursuit of happiness.



Maiden Rated PG 97 minutes Documentary

Age 13+ 5/5 Stars. Story of how Tracy Edwards, a 24 year old cook in charter boats, became the skipper of the first ever all-female crew to enter the Whitbread Round the World in 1989. Details the opposition she had to compete and the struggles to ensure the team went on. Enthralling sailing photography. Some language and suggestive content.



On the Basis of Sex Rated PG-13 120 minutes Bio

Age 12+ 3/5 Stars. Well-acted biographical drama about Supreme Court Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg's early life and career to her first groundbreaking gender-discrimination case in the early 1970s. Includes some scenes of non-marital affection and intimacy and some language. Audience take away message s abot perseverance, integrity and equal opportunities for all.
