Library card holders may check out and download eBooks anytime, anywhere by visiting the Wisconsin Public Library Consortium site powered by OverDrive at

<http://dbooks.wplc.info>

Users may browse the website (also video, audio, and music available), check out with a valid library card, and download to PC or Mac.

Users will need to install free Adobe Digital Editions software.

Titles may be enjoyed immediately or transferred to a variety of devices, including the Nook, Sony Reader, Kobo, Literati, Pandigital, iPad, iPhone, Android, and more! (Amazon Kindle is currently not compatible).

If the item you want is not available, place a hold and you will be notified by email when the book becomes available and you then have 3 days to download it.

Free OverDrive eBooks

What do you need?

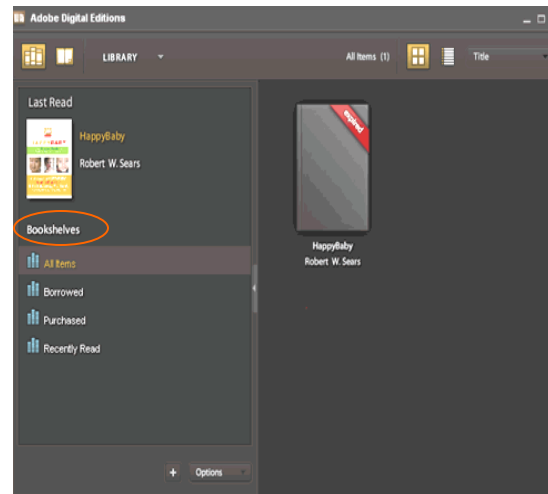
- A Winding Rivers Library Card
- A computer (minimum: Win 2000 SP4 or Mac v10.4.10)
- Internet access
- An eReader that can display DRM-protected Adobe ePub or pdf eBooks which includes most Nooks, Sony Readers, Kobo, Pandigital, Literati, iPad, iPhone, Android, and more! *Sorry but Kindles do not work with OverDrive at this time.*

How does it work?

1. Go to <http://dbooks.wplc.info>
2. Download and install the free Adobe Digital Editions software.
3. Activate using an Adobe ID. If you activate anonymously, no transfers to eReaders are allowed.
4. Plug in your eReader and activate it using the same Adobe ID. It will display in the Adobe Digital Editions software. (Note: Sony Readers must have v1.1 firmware 7, the Sony eBook Library software installed on your computer.)

Check Out Books

1. Sign in to the OverDrive web site using your library barcode.
2. Check out a book by clicking "Add to my Cart" & then "Proceed to Checkout".
3. Choose your checkout time period. You have a choice of a 7 day or 14 day checkout.
4. Confirm your checkout and download the book. When prompted, open the book with Adobe Digital Editions.
5. Adobe Digital Editions will automatically open. Follow the prompts and your download will begin!
6. Plug your device in. It will show in Adobe Digital Editions. (Directly under Bookshelves) - see below



7. Click and drag your new books to the device, unplug and enjoy!

Returning Books

1. eBooks will automatically expire themselves after the allotted time span. (7 or 14 days) You will have to manually delete the files from your computer & eReader.
2. To return an item early, hover your mouse over the book in Adobe Digital Editions. Click on the Item Options arrow.
3. Click on "Return Borrowed Item".

eBooks may be checked out for one or two weeks, your choice.

Files automatically expire themselves at the end of the checkout period but must be deleted from your computer & reader. There are no renewals available in OverDrive.

You may check out up to 6 items at a time.
